

- The 'Subject to Deductible' field was removed from the Benefits Package sheet. Therefore, the interaction between a benefit's Copay/Coinsurance and the deductible is now mapped directly from the values entered in the Copay and Coinsurance columns on the Cost Share Variance sheet of the Plans & Benefits template.
- It is extremely important to ensure that the correct values are selected when inputting the Copay and Coinsurance. Failure to select the correct indicator may cause incorrect AV calculations or incorrect values to display on Plan Compare for consumers.
- To properly indicate how a benefit is subject to the deductible.
 - When there is **no** deductible or a particular benefit is **not** subject to the deductible enter
 - 'No Charge' or
 - 'Not Applicable' or
 - For copays: the applicable dollar amount with the drop-down option of '\$X' or
 - For coinsurance: the applicable percentage with the drop-down option of 'X%'.
 - When there **is** a deductible or a particular benefit **is** subject to the deductible enter
 - 'No Charge after deductible' or
 - For copays: the applicable dollar amount with the drop-down option of '\$X after deductible' or '\$X before deductible' or
 - For coinsurance: the applicable percentage with the drop-down option of 'X% after deductible'.
