3. discharging and releasing the rehabilitator and his
deputies, agents and employees of all
responsibility and liability.

finds the Motion is well taken.


THEREFORE, it is hereby authorized and ORDERED as
follows:

1. The Court hereby approves the Final Account of the
Rehabilitator.
2. The Court finds that the grounds for the
rehabilitation of Manchester under §3903.12 of the Revised Code no
longer exist, and therefore, the Court hereby terminates the
rehabilitation of Manchester and orders that Manchester be restored
to possession of its property and control of its business.

3. The Court hereby discharges and releases the Rehabilitator, his predecessors, successors, and any and all deputies, employees, agents and attorneys of the liquidation office of the Ohio Department of Insurance and the Ohio Department of Insurance of all responsibility and liability in connection with the conservatorship, liquidation and rehabilitation of Manchester.



MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT

The Rehabilitator originally filed his Motion of Rehabilitator for Approval of Final Account, Termination of Rehabilitation Estate and Discharge and Release of Rehabilitator on May 1, 1991. As represented in the Memorandum in Support of that Motion, the distribution to all claimants who timely filed Proofs of Claim has been completed and all appropriate and approved expenses of the rehabilitation estate have been paid, or reserves have been established to ensure such payment, pursuant to this Court's Order of September 30, 1987. The only claims remaining at the time of the Rehabilitator's prior Motion were those of American Mutual Reinsurance Company ("AMRECO") and Crawford & Company. Those appeals have been finally and completely settled with approval of this Court. Therefore, there are no remaining issues in this action to be resolved.

Therefore, because the rehabilitation has been accomplished and the grounds for rehabilitation under §3903.12 of the Revised Code no longer exist, the Rehabilitator asks this Court to grant his Motion for Approval of Final Account, Termination of Rehabilitation and Discharge and Release of Rehabilitator. A copy of the proposed Order is attached hereto as "Exhibit A."

The Rehabilitator's final account is filed simultaneously with this Motion.
