**ENTRY AND ORDER GRANTING THE CREDIT GENERAL INSURANCE COMPANY LIQUIDATOR’S MOTION FOR AN ORDER APPROVING (1) THE LIQUIDATOR’S DISALLOWANCE AND DETERMINATION OF UNDELIVERABLE CLAIMS AND (2) FILING OF THE UNREDACTED REPORTS OF UNDELIVERABLE CLAIMS UNDER SEAL**

This matter came before the Court upon the Liquidator’s Motion and Memorandum in Support of Motion for an Order Approving the Liquidator’s Disallowance and Determination of Undeliverable Claims and the Filing of Unredacted Reports of Undeliverable Claims Under Seal (the “Motion”).

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, AND ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Motion is, GRANTED in its entirety; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Liquidator’s zero value determinations and disallowance of claims identified on Exhibit A, attached to the Motion, is approved because those claimants failed to notify the Liquidator of address change as required under R.C. § 3903.22;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Liquidator’s disallowance of certain other claims, for which the Liquidator assigned a value greater than zero, as identified on Exhibit A attached to the Motion, but could not successfully deliver a notice of determination of value, is approved because those claimants failed to notify the Liquidator of address change as required under R.C. § 3903.22 and that there are no “unclaimed funds” as provided under R.C. § 3903.45(A) as a result of the disallowance of all Claims identified on Exhibit A .

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, due to the confidential and private nature of the information contained in Exhibit A to the Motion, the Liquidator’s *Motion for Order Approving Liquidator’s Filing of the Unredacted Reports of Undeliverable Claims Under Seal* is GRANTED and that the Unredacted Exhibit A to the Motion shall be filed with the Franklin County Clerk of Court UNDER SEAL.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Credit General Insurance Company Estate, the Liquidator, the Liquidator’s predecessors, successors, assigns and any and all deputy liquidators, agents, attorneys and employees of the *Office of the Ohio Insurance Liquidator* and the Ohio Department of Insurance, are discharged and fully released from any and all liability and responsibility related to all of the undeliverable claims.
