JUDGMENT ENTRY

The plaintiff has filed a Motion asking the Court to approve a Notice to be sent to all Interested Parties (as defined in the Motion) advising them of the filing by the plaintiff of a Motion for Approval of the First Amended Plan of Rehabilitation. The Court finds the Notice to be acceptable and that the Interested Parties are the only individuals and entities, upon whom the Notice need be served. Therefore, the plaintiff's Motion is GRANTED. The plaintiff is hereby ordered to send a copy of this Notice to all Interested Parties by regular mail no later than the 3rd day of February, 2006.

The plaintiff has also moved the Court for an Order scheduling a time by which written objections shall be filed with the Court with regard to the Motion for Approval of the First Amended Plan of Rehabilitation and a time by which the plaintiff may respond to those objections. That Motion is GRANTED. Any and all objections by interested parties shall be filed with the Court, in writing, no later than the 24th day of February, 2006.

The plaintiff shall have until the 10th day of March, 2006 to file written responses to those objections.

Further, the Court hereby schedules a hearing on the plaintiff's Motion for Approval of the First Amended Plan of Rehabilitation on the 21st day of APRIL, 2006 at 8:30 a.m.
