ORDER

At this Court's Status Conference on September 29, 2008, this cause came before this Court at the request of Plaintiff, Mary Jo Hudson, in her capacity as Rehabilitator ("Rehabilitator") of Defendant Guarantee Title and Trust Company ("GTT"), by and through counsel, for an Order to permit the Rehabilitator to engage Visual Evidence/E-Discovery LLC ("Visual Evidence"). GTT's counsel Randall S. Rabe offered no objection to the Rehabilitator's request.

Over the course of the past several weeks, the Rehabilitator has been in ongoing discussions concerning access to any and all information, electronic or otherwise, related to or pertaining to GTT. These discussions have been with Christopher M. Likens, GTT's owner; Hiram Bloomquist, GTT's President; Nations Holding Company, Inc.; other Likens' owned affiliates and subsidiaries ("Nations"); and their employees, who work in the office building that also houses GTT. Through these discussions, the Rehabilitator determined the breadth and depth

of the commingling of the GTT and Nations' information. Given the commingled state of the electronic information, among other factors, the Rehabilitator has determined it necessary to engage an electronic information collection and storage company.

To that end, on October 13, 2008, Visual Evidence will travel to GTT's offices in Prairie Village, Kansas in an effort to: (i) collect data by imaging the personal computers (PCs) of individuals who worked for GTT or on matters pertaining to or related to GTT; (ii) collect, through the use of Visual Evidence's harvesting method, the contents of all network servers which have any GTT information or information pertaining to or related to GTT, regardless of system ownership; (iii) convert the email of any and all persons who worked on matters pertaining to or related to GTT into .PST files, regardless of where the information is stored; and copy that information; and (iv) consult with the Rehabilitator, as requested, in the general field of electronically stored information and perform any and all additional tasks related to the collection, storage, conversion and/or copying of GTT's electronic information, as requested by the Rehabilitator. Visual Evidence will store all information collected at its facilities in Cleveland, Ohio and will produce working copies as directed by the Rehabilitator.

For good cause shown, the Rehabilitator's request is hereby GRANTED.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Rehabilitator may engage Visual Evidence and Visual Evidence is hereby appointed to capture, collect, image, harvest, copy, store and perform similar tasks regarding all electronic information as described by the Rehabilitator to this Court beginning October 13, 2008, in Prairie Village, Kansas and, as may further be required by the Rehabilitator; to consult with the Rehabilitator in the field of electronically stored information; and to provide the Rehabilitator with any other services she deems necessary.


