Undeliverable Claims Report for Credit General Insurance Company June 20, 2014

The Liquidator filed a motion requesting a Court Order approving the Liquidator's determinations and disallowances of Credit General Insurance Company claims identified on Exhibit A to the Motion because the Liquidator could not successfully deliver notice to the listed claimants of her determinations (the "Undeliverable Claims") because these claimants failed to notify the Liquidator of address changes as required under Ohio Revised Code (R.C.) § 3903.22 and the Liquidator could not otherwise locate these claimants.

Claimants may search for to see if their claim is an Undeliverable Claim using their Credit General Insurance Company Proof of Claim (Liquidator) Number. If a claimant finds their Proof of Claim (Liquidator) Number on the Exhibit A, the claimant may call the Liquidation Office to verify information regarding their claim.

Please note that the Liquidator will not be paying any Credit General Insurance Company claims filed in priority Classes 3 through 9 as there are insufficient funds available in the Credit General Insurance Company liquidation estate to pay any of these claims.
