

# 2016 OSHIIP New Volunteer Trainings

The Ohio Senior Health Insurance Information Program (OSHIIP) announces initial training sessions for people interested in becoming OSHIIP volunteers.



Unless otherwise noted, training is from 9 a.m. - 3 p.m. with a one hour lunch the first four days. Day five is normally 10 a.m. - noon. This is the initial OSHIIP volunteer training and participants must attend all five sessions to be certified.

Please be prepared to complete a volunteer application and liability form the first day of training. Please bring contact information for three references: a working supervisor, a co-worker or relative and another person of your choice.

Licensed insurance agents, or those affiliated with an insurance company, a claims filing service or financial planning service are not eligible for our program. Being an OSHIIP volunteer would constitute a conflict of interest.
