**ORDER APPROVING LIQUIDATOR'S REPORTS OF CLASS 4, 5 AND 6 CLAIMS,
DISTRIBUTION TO CLASS 5 AND 6 CLAIMANTS, AND FORECLOSURE AND/OR
DISALLOWANCE OF ANY CONTINGENT OR FUTURE CLASS 4, 5 OR 6 CLAIMS
NOT INCLUDED IN THE REPORTS OF CLAIMS AND NOT PREVIOUSLY
DISALLOWED OR ZERO VALUED**

This matter came on to be heard on the Motion of the Liquidator of Oil and Gas Insurance Company (OGICO) for Approval of Liquidator's Reports of Class 4, Class 5, and Class 6 Claims, Distribution to Class 5 and Class 6 Claimants, and Foreclosure and/or Disallowance of Any Contingent or Future Class 4, Class 5 or Class 6 Claims Not Included in the Reports of Claims and Not Previously Disallowed or Zero Valued. Upon consideration of the Liquidator's Motion, Memorandum in Support and Exhibits, the Court finds the Motion well taken, and it is Ordered, Adjudged and Decreed as follows:

1. The Court approves the Liquidator's Reports of Class 4, Class 5 and Class 6 Claims and the values of the Claims as set forth therein, attached to the Liquidator's Motion and Memorandum in Support of the Motion as Exhibits A, B and C;
2. The Court authorizes the distribution of OGICO assets in the amount of

Nineteen Million, Nine Hundred Seventy Thousand, Five Hundred Eighty-seven Dollars and Sixty-eight Cents (\$19,970,587.68) payable in accordance with the Report of Claims (Exhibit B), as listed therein, to Class 5 Claimants;

3. The Court authorizes the distribution of OGICO assets in the amount of Ninety-one Thousand, Four Hundred Seventy-nine dollars and Eighty-nine Cents (\$91,479.89), payable in accordance with the Report of Claims (Exhibit C), as listed therein, to Class 6 Claimants;

4. The Court orders that any contingent or future Class 4, Class 5 or Class 6 Claims or any Class 4, 5, or 6 claims not included in the Liquidator's Reports of Class 4, Class 5 and Class 6 Claims and not previously disallowed or zero valued are hereby foreclosed and/or disallowed.
