The NAIC Global Receivership Information Database contains information regarding insurance companies currently in receivership or recently in receivership.

Due to the age of this insolvency, the *Office of the Ohio Insurance Liquidator* has very limited information regarding the receivership proceeding.

The limited records reflect that on November 16, 1973, Globe Assurance Company was placed into conservatorship pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Chapter 3903. On May 14, 1974, Globe Assurance Company was found to be insolvent and ordered into liquidation. On April 8, 1983, the Globe Assurance liquidation was ordered closed and the Liquidator was discharged. Then, on November 26, 1986, the Globe Assurance liquidation was re-opened when a check from the bankruptcy proceeding of the company's parent (Globe Capital Corporation) was received. The Globe Assurance liquidation was ordered closed again on December 31, 1991. See the Final Closing Order under Public Documents.

The records of this receivership proceeding were destroyed following closure.
